

Portfolio Assignment

Note: This is a test grade

You need to pick 3 problems from your homework, your worksheets or your workbook to focus on.

- 1 problem needs to be something that you struggled with initially, but were able to master

- 1 problem needs to be something that you struggled with, and are still unsure about

- 1 problem can be something that you consider to be your best work

You need to create 3 pages; 1 for each problem (you will also create a cover page and a final reflection for a total of 5 pages). On each page you need to include the following:

- The problem itself, and where it came from. If it's from the workbook, then what page? If it's from a worksheet, then please include the worksheet in the back of the packet as evidence. If it's from homework, then please include the homework in the back of the packet as evidence. *THIS IS THE SUPPORTING EVIDENCE*

- If the problem was hard for you, but you mastered it, then you need to show me how you worked it out originally, and then how you re-worked it. *Please include a description about what made it easier.*
- If the problem is still a struggle for you, then tell me how far you're able to get, and where it breaks down for you. *Descriptions such as "I have no idea" will not be accepted.*
- If the problem is your finest work, then tell me what made it easy for you.

This needs to come with a cover sheet that includes your name, the date, and which block you are in. It also needs a final reflection on the first term; what do you think you did well and what do you think you could do better? The final reflection isn't about the specific problems you've already written about, it's about the term as a whole. Note: I expect this section to be VERY specific!

Use the goals you wrote for yourself for this term to guide your reflection. Did you live up to the goals? What do you wish you had done differently?
